Education

The current state of education in the UK is very much below the standards expected of a modern First World Country. Children are now taught so many unnecessary lessons like gender studies, humanities, and others along a similar vain, they have very little time to learn about important lesson. These New Age lessons are being forced onto our children's young minds by teachers who have a twisted view of the world. Who's own qualities and qualifications are well below what is needed to teach children to be free thinkers, who can think for themselves and become the great adults that any nation needs if it is to survive.

All children will be state schooled to a very high standard. If a parent wishes their children to be home-schooled, etc. then they will have to make the necessary steps themselves, but that child will still need to take the same exams and score the same as a state schooled child.

All schools will have a strong male presence in the classroom, with at least a 50/50 mix between men and women, to ensure the pupils are being educated correctly, and so there's a strong masculine teacher to look up to.

From birth, and up to their 5th Birthday children will be nurtured by the family unit. Where the parents still need to work crèches will be encouraged at their place of work. Even small companies will be encouraged to do this, especially where they have a high number of female workers. One method of ensuring there is always someone available to run the crèche would be where the workers are allowed one hour out of their shift on a rota system allowing the others to work. Those woman without children of their own would also participate which will give them invaluable experience with children.

Once the child has passed their 5th Birthday they will be enrolled into their local state school. The school year starts on the first Monday after the 3rd of January, and runs until the Friday before the 12th of December. This gives parents at least 3 weeks to prepare both themselves and their child. The school term will be 6 weeks of 5 days, followed by 1 week of rest and relaxation.

During the first few years of schooling the children's education will predominantly be English and Maths, along with a good amount of physical training and competitive sports (football, rugby, running, for example), and inter-school competitions will be encouraged. Technology will also be present in these early years, with the children having good access to computers as both a learning aid, and also learning about computers as well.

During their 5th year of education (at the age of ten) the focus of their education will shift so they are learning more about British history and language. Physical education will be even more dominant, as will the three science's (Physics, Chemistry, and Biology), along with Technology. Home Economics will also be introduced and every student is expected to be able to look after themselves once they leave school.

From the age of 12 onwards the students will have the option to attend school for an additional 5 hours on Saturday mornings if they wish. The lessons during this Saturday period will be flexible, and will be at the students choice, this will give the student a chance to have a different tutor for that subject.

All students from 16 years of age will be expected to mentor a student who has just started their first year at that school. This will encourage an older student to learn social responsibilities, and will give the younger student a better start.

Once the student reaches their 17th Birthday they can leave school (as long as they have actually completed the 12 years of education) and then enrol for higher education for free. As with the current system the student must have scored high enough in their chosen field to make this worthwhile. The actual courses they can enrol on will be trimmed down to what is considered essential, and any non-essential fields of further education must be completed at the students own expense. An example list is shown below.

Those students who do not wish to go into academic further education will be allowed to join a trade school where they can train for an essential trade; plumbing, electrician, engineer, etc. These courses will be available to all students.

National Service

All students will leave full-time education at the age of 19 before enrolling for National Service from three weeks after their 19th Birthday.

To start, the recruits will go through the standard 8 weeks of basic training for the service they have chosen – Air Force, Army, or Navy. Once they graduate they will then become full time service personnel. Throughout their service to their country education and trade training will still be provided and all service personal are expected to have a high level of education and diverse skill-set.

The compulsory term of service is two years after basic training is complete, and after this term of service they can either leave the service and enjoy life as a civilian, or they can stay on for additional years up to a maximum of 22 in the lower ranks, with no upper limit in the higher ranks.

The priority for service personnel is to ensure the safety and security of the British Isles and its dependent overseas territories. We will not participate in foreign conflicts unless there is an immediate direct threat, or if there is potential for threat later.

All three branches of our armed services will always have a sufficient level of personnel to ensure they are ready to go, and with enough force, regardless of the conflict. Our overseas interests will have their armed forces presence ramped up, with a regular flow of personnel performing various tours.

Once trained to a satisfactory level our personnel will be given the option to participate in foreign conflicts in the capacity of state sponsored mercenaries. The foreign nation will pay up front for the services we offer, and the personnel themselves will then receive that payment once their tour of service is complete. At all times the personnel will be under direct control of

the UK, and unless there is an immediate threat to their safety, orders will only be followed from the UK.

During periods of reduced activity the service personnel will be allowed to return home and rest for a few days before returning again.

Our membership of the UN and NATO will be scrutinised to see if it is still fit for purpose. If found lacking then we will submit our findings and recommendations, and if none of these recommendations are implemented then our membership will be assessed - with the option to leave.

Tours of service in our overseas territories and dependencies will be compulsory, and will be planned and run better by those already performing this service.

An insurance policy will be created for each service personnel which will be paid out to their next of kin in the unfortunate event of their death during service. This is in addition to any monies gained while in service.

Citizenship

Upon leaving the service all personnel will be granted full citizenship of the UK of GB. This honour allows the citizen certain benefits that non-citizens will not receive. On a financial front the citizen will receive discounts on loans, HP agreements, and mortgages, along with better rates of interest on their savings.

On the material front it allows the citizen discounts on certain items from participating outlets, especially if they have started a business.

The amount of benefits received increases with each additional year completed in service. Although each increase will seem small, those completing a full 22 year will easily see the benefits they've accrued.

Government

Those who do not go through National Service will not be allowed to work for Government at any level. Those who are unable to do National Service for physical reasons, but can offer great value in other ways will be allowed a role in Government, but their status will always be below someone who has been through national service.

Only candidates who are 5th generation or greater UK citizen can apply for higher position jobs, with a preference to those whose ancestry dates even further back. Those who cling to their religious beliefs over their loyalty to the state will not be allowed to hold any government role in any capacity whatsoever.

All current politicians will be investigated for their role in the currently planned downfall of the UK (and Europe and beyond).

Family

Parents of children of all ages will be expected to have an active role in their child's education and early years training. Extra curricular activities will be encouraged both individually and through group run activities such as the schools or third parties such as Scouts, Brownies, etc. Close attention will be paid to the children so any hidden talent can be identified and nurtured. Along with this the Scouts and Guides will be promoted and encouraged.

Too many young boys are being told that they are toxic just for being born a male, that masculinity is toxic, when in fact the opposite is true. A true masculine man doesn't beat up a woman, nor does he lord it over others. A true masculine man cares for and nurtures others, he seeks out and helps create strong relationships and strong family ties.

Toxic feminists are the true destroyers of the family unit, they strive to destroy relationships as a way to justify their own beliefs and existence. It is a proven fact children, especially boys, who are brought up in a woman dominant home is more likely to turn to crime, they're more likely to have no goals or ambitions in life, and they're least likely to succeed. Health

The NHS consumes more money than what the UK spends on defence, and most of this is because of waste. Whether it's the burden of too much bureaucracy or procurement systems that are not economical due to over-pricing we will introduce changes – from the top down.

All medical training will be free to anyone who wants to go into the medical profession. The only stipulation is that they must work in the medical profession for at least ten years, and if they decide to leave for another country within that period then they must repay their tuition costs.

At the moment we have thousands of trainee doctors and nurses who cannot get a job in the NHS because of government interference and localised bureaucracy. Foreign nationals are encouraged to come to the UK and do the jobs that our own jobless trainees can and should be doing. What is never mentioned is the dire consequences on that other country when all of their medical staff are over here instead. We will stop this! Where possible we will help these countries develop their own healthcare by training their own people, and by ensuring that they retain those staff so they can look after and successfully treat their own people.

Accident and Emergency departments will be free to all of those who have gained citizenship through their service to the country, and also those who have proven heritage in the UK, which currently stands where at least 5 generations have been living legally in the UK. Once all of the heritage users have died off through natural processes then only those with citizenship will have access to free health care.

Foreign nationals and those who do not meet the above minimum standards will be expected to take out health insurance, which must be presented before any health care is given. So it is essential they carry ID around with them at all times. Failure to show their insurance card or those who do not have insurance will be directed to the many free-to-use health centres instead.

Ongoing health issues will be free to all of those who have gained citizenship through their service to the country, and also those who have proven heritage in the UK. Everyone else will need to pay for their ongoing treatment through personal wealth or medical insurance.

Voluntarily run health and medical centres will be encouraged but will receive no state funding beyond financial help to get started. They must receive their funding through private donations and charity work.

All medical staff will be expected to give up some of their free time to work at these free-to-use health centres. The state will still pay them for working at one of these centres, but at a slightly reduced rate.

Food production

All households will have access to an allotment where they can grow fruit and vegetables of their own choosing. Where it isn't possible to develop an allotment local farmers will be encouraged to put aside a field for this purpose.

Although produce from these allotments will mainly be for the consumption of those who've grown the crops, those with larger plots will be encouraged to open stalls where the crops can be sold to those not lucky enough to have their own plot. Chemicals will not be allowed on the allotments in any shape or form. Anyone found using chemicals on their crops will be immediately banned from growing on the allotment. Those using their own gardens will be discouraged from using chemicals, and will not be allowed to sell or give away their crops if they do.

Land once used for solar farms will be returned to their natural growing use after their useful life has expired, which is usually around 25 years for the panels and considerably less for the infrastructure. No money will be made available to the land owners for this, as they've already received more than enough compensation as it is in the form of tax-payer funded incentives.

Where possible all of the UK's food supply will be grown locally, with as little as possible imported. Obviously some foods can only be grown abroad, and we will still need to import these for the foreseeable future, but it is hoped that with advances in farming this will change.

We WILL take back control of our fishing waters, and we WILL defend them rigorously against any and all transgressors.

Crime and Punishment

All crime will be investigated, regardless of how petty it seems in this current climate. It is expected that crime will eventually fall to very low levels due to a mixture of guaranteed punishment when caught, and with a renewed desire to be a good citizen and being a person with purpose.

Punishments range from social care work (litter picking, lawn care, etc) for petty crimes, up to capital punishment for murder, crimes against children, etc. For the most serious of crimes prisoners will be put on 'Death Row' for five years to allow time for any new evidence to be submitted for consideration.

Currently punishments for a crime can vary considerably depending on the sitting judge, and how good the legal team on both sides are. This isn't fair, even if clearly guilty the criminal should still expect a fairness that is not based on his political beliefs or the colour of his skin. Therefore we propose all serious crimes should have the court files reviewed by an independent judge who has no previous exposure to the persons involved. Where anonymity of the case details cannot be guaranteed then a panel of judges will preside.

Religion

The UK will become a true secular state, but will maintain the so-called Christian Values that have served us well. Everyone has the right to believe in which ever religion they please, but they must keep it as their own private religion. All public places of worship will be closed, the land reclaimed and developed upon. Any public gatherings will be dispersed as soon as they are formed.

Religious groups will no longer be able to claim the benefits they currently receive - they will not have their current presence and influence in politics, nor will they receive their current financial benefits.

Transport

Road

The roads are a mess, there's no other word to describe them, and they're only going to get worse. Successive governments have collected £billions from road users by charging them multiple levels of taxation, but have invested very little of that money back into the infrastructure. Typical problems are pot-holes, frost induced cracks and layer separation, poorly painted lines and directions, especially on roundabouts. Even newly laid roads have dangerous undulations causing vehicles to weave unexpectedly. Local authorities would rather pay out compensation to road users if their vehicle is damaged by a road obstacle rather than perform routine maintenance. This is not acceptable.

We will ensure roads are maintained correctly, with local authorities being responsible for their roads, with the financial help from central government.

Trains

Finance

The money system of the West is a scam! It's geared towards keeping the general population poor, and the very few that truly knows how it works very, very rich. Saddam Hussein knew this, as did Muammar Gaddafi, this is the true reason the US, and the coalition forces invaded Iraq, and then destabilised Libya. Foreign Aid

The money the UK gives to most countries from the Foreign Aid Budget is not to help the people directly of these countries directly, but to appease the government of these countries not to oppress the people they represent. Regional fossil-fuel power stations have now been shut down, and can never economically be brought back online, meaning the number of heavy-duty power generation is widely spaced across the country with very little room for failure across the grid. Due to this dispersal of power stations the countryside has been blighted with transmission lines all over the once protected countryside.

We will investigate the use of Thorium reactors, and if successful we will install mini Thorium power station across the country. This will negate the need for so much expensive and inefficient transmission of power. Where possible power lines will be submerged in walkable tunnels.

We will investigate the use of hemp for biofuel production. Hemp is more energy dense than corn while growing roughly 25% faster and does not rely on fertilizers nor chemicals to grow a healthy crop.

We will investigate the use of tidal power generation. Although current estimate state we can get a reliable 50% of our total electrical energy from tidal power generation we are not so easily convinced. Therefore we propose to build and run a small number of research tidal generators to ensure very little detrimental effects to our fishing waters.

Once the initial cost of these systems have been recouped then the cost to the customer will be minimised. We understand that it can never be free due to ongoing costs and research, but we will not 'rip-off' the people as they currently are.
